Compliance with Board of Regents' Policy 301.12, Undergraduate Degree Requirements; Associate Degrees and Certificates of Applied Science, and Moratorium Status for Programs That Are Still Out of Compliance

THAT:

The Board of Regents of Higher Education for the State of Montana place the following program on moratorium because it is out of compliance with the provisions of Policy 301.12:

- the Certificate of Applied Science in Building Technology at Miles Community College.

EXPLANATION:

In September 2007, the Montana Board of Regents received a list of Associate of Applied Science and Certificate of Applied Science degree programs that did not conform to the guidelines set out in Policy 301.12. The Board of Regents approved an action item, at that meeting, that required all programs on that list to either 1) conform to the policy expectations by the March 2008 meeting; or 2) be placed on moratorium at the May 2008 meeting until they are brought into compliance.

The program listed above is still out of compliance with Policy 301.12 at the time of this meeting in May 2008.
