Upon the occasion of the retirement of Daniel Shaffer from the faculty of Montana State University, the Board of Regents wishes to express its appreciation for his service to the University, the Montana University System, and the people of the State of Montana.

EXPLANATION:

Dr. Daniel Shaffer completed his undergraduate work at the University of Delaware before earning both an MS and PhD at the Pennsylvania State University. He worked for the Celanese Corporation for over a decade before coming to Montana State University in 1982.
