
MONTANA TECH CURRENT CAMPUS STATUS



- Enrollment Increased 248 FTE Since FY05 (12.6%)
 - > 74 Resident (4.4%)
 - > 174 Non-Resident (63.6%)
- Maintaining 2% Enrollment Contingency
 - > Exceeded FTE Projections Which Allowed for OTO Expenditures
- Recruiting and Retaining Faculty
 - > Critical to Maintaining Quality and Student/Faculty Ratio
 - > Faculty Leaving for Higher Salaries
- Honoring Scholarship Commitments
- Preparing to Relocate Personnel to the Natural Resources Building and Move Nursing Department to the North Campus

MONTANA TECH IMPACTS OF TUITION FREEZE



- Eliminate OTO Funding and Maintenance Projects
- Reduce Enrollment Contingency
- Request Authority to Use Reserve Revolving Account to Cover Costs or Shortfalls
- Determine Criticality of Vacant Positions Before Filling
- Other Factors
 - ➤ Insufficient Funding to Move into Natural Resource Building
 - > Vulnerability of Dependency On Non-Resident Enrollment
 - ➤ Maintain Existing Programs Without Compromising Quality
