ITEM 145-2703-R1109 <u>Student Equipment Fee Allocation; Montana State</u> <u>University- Billings</u>

THAT: Consistent with the provisions of Board of Regents' policy 940.26, the Board of Regents authorizes Montana State University Billings to expend Student Equipment Fee funds for the following projects that exceed the local approval threshold:

- College of Arts & Sciences \$580,000 art, science and music equipment; computer, recording and electronic equipment.
- College of Business \$12,000 computer and projection equipment.
- College of Technology \$405,000 various equipment and furnishing items for drafting, fire sciences, automotive, diesel, health sciences, and computer technology programs.
- College of Professional Studies & Lifelong Learning -\$30,000 – electronic computer, projection and recording equipment.
- College of Allied Health Professions \$5,000 medical equipment.
- College of Education \$105,000 computer, projection and reading electronic equipment.
- Library \$20,000 equipment and furnishings.
- Student Affairs Academic Support Center and Disability Services \$15,000 computer and electronic equipment.
- Other academic areas \$35,000 computer, recording and survey equipment and software.

Total - \$1,207,000

EXPLANATION: Board of Regents' Policy 940.26 requires Board approval of all purchases over \$25,000. The Student Equipment Fee Committee, whose membership includes 50 percent students, endorses this proposal. These updates/improvements directly benefit the University students and their learning environment. The equipment will provide a primary benefit to the educational program including library and other related capital acquisitions.
