The following revisions shall be incorporated into the collective bargaining agreement:

The following are the items which were approved by the Faculty Association and the Administration:

- A) Faculty Compensation FY 2009-2010: \$450 OTO/non-base building 0.5 FTE/AY to less than 1.0 FTE/AY \$225; 1.0 FTE/AY \$450
- B) MOA Class 8 Dual Credit: Agreed to implement (11/20/08) Faculty yet to ratify; Expires June 20, 2011
- C) <u>CBA Section 8.200 Department Chair Duties and Responsibilities</u>: Agreed on new statement covering department chair duties and responsibilities (yet to be ratified by faculty)
- D) <u>Section 9.333 Criteria for Rank Advancement</u>: Agreed that an application for rank advancement may be presented for consideration at the same time as an application for tenure – during sixth year of full-time probationary period. (yet to be ratified by faculty) (3/30/09.
- E) <u>Section 9.336 Basis of Exception</u>: Agreed to modify the basis for exception language (yet to be ratified by faculty) (3/20/09)
- F) <u>Section 8.110 Transfer of Titles Department Chair</u>

Section 8.200 - Duties and Responsibilities:

Agreed to modify language covering department chair duties and responsibilities (4/20/09)

- G) CBA Section 9.332 Responsibility for Application (11/30/09)
- H) Language modification Position Descriptions (tenured faculty) (11/30/09)
