SUBJECT: ACADEMIC AFFAIRS

Policy 301.4.1 - Enrollment limitations; MSU-Bozeman

Effective: June 21, 1991; Issued: September 28, 1994 Approved: April 12, 1977; Revised: March 4, 2011

I. Board policy:

Montana State University-Bozeman is authorized to limit enrollment in nursing and/or upper division nursing classes.

II. Procedures:

- A. Assignments to upper division (clinical) nursing classes shall be prioritized based upon a compilation of grade point averages in those courses designated by the <u>school-college</u> of nursing as having the greatest relevance and/or predictive value for success in nursing.
- B. Students seeking assignment to upper division nursing courses shall be considered for a place through a petition an application procedure, such consideration being secured by a fee, which shall be refunded if a place cannot be offered.
- C. Montana State University-Bozeman is authorized to collect a <u>reasonable</u> non-refundable nursing upper division <u>application</u> <u>deposit petition deposit in the amount of \$50.00. The deposit would serve to secure an offered placement in the upper division nursing (clinical) course work. The deposit will be applied against the student's <u>tuition and</u> fees when the student registers in the first assigned semester of upper division nursing courses.</u>
