SUBJECT: FINANCIAL AFFAIRS

Policy 940.18 - Course audit fee; matriculated students *Effective November 18, 1999; Issued December 10, 1999*

Board policy:

- 1. Each president and chancellor is authorized to assess a course audit fee to all regularly enrolled students who elect to take a course for no credit. The student will pay the normal per-credit-hour fee.
 - 2. The revenue from course audit fees shall be deposited in current operating account.
- 3. Students enrolled as auditors shall be accounted for in accordance with the Registrar's Manual for Reporting Enrollment Data.
