
Fiscal Year Enrollment Report – FY12

- Enrollment growth in the MUS leveled off in 2012 after three years of accelerated growth
- ❖ Total FTE remains over 40,000 FTE despite slight decline in FY12 (-.3%)
- ❖ Enrollment has grown by approximately 6,500 FTE (19%) in the past ten years, with over 80% of the growth occurring since 2008





Student FTE by Residency & Level

1-Year Comparison

- ❖ -0.3% decline compared to last fiscal year, equaling a drop of 115 FTE
- Resident Undergraduates witnessed the largest decline (-404; -1.4%)
- ❖ Non-resident Undergraduates experienced the largest increase (286; 5.1%)

- ❖ 19% growth over last ten years, equaling an increase of 6,515 FTE
- Resident students represent the majority of the growth (+4,356 FTE), 67% of the total increase



- ❖ 4-year campuses recorded the largest numerical increase (+3,184 FTE)

MT High School Graduates

- Due to declining high school age population, the number of public high school graduates has decreased by 700 students in the past seven years
- While the MUS capture rate has increased, the number attending immediately following graduation has started to decline
- ❖ Fall 2011 headcount report: 1st-time resident enrollment down 360 students
