## **Summary & Analysis**

Over the past six years, aggregate system-wide retention rates in the MUS for both 2-year and 4-year sectors increased slightly.

At 4-year colleges throughout the region (i.e. WICHE peer states) the average <u>institutional</u> retention rate is 77%; the MUS 4-year college aggregate <u>system-wide</u> retention rate is 76%.

- Fall 2011 cohort (high) Institutional Rate: UM Missoula 76%, UM Western 75%, MSU Bozeman 74%
- Fall 2011 cohort (low) Institutional Rate: MSU Billings 56%, MSU Northern 58%

At 2-year colleges throughout the region the average institutional retention rate is 57%; the MUS 2-year college aggregate system-wide retention rate is 57%.

- Fall 2011 cohort (high) Institutional Rate: Gallatin College 74%
- Fall 2011 cohort (high/middle) Miles 59%, Flathead 56%, Helena College 55%
- Fall 2011 cohort (low) Institutional Rate: Dawson CC 41%

Campuses that experienced the most growth in retention (both inst. and system-wide) over the past 6 years are:

- Great Falls College: +10.6% institutional; +14.1% system-wide
- UM Western (bach. cohort): +9.3% institutional; +13.8% system-wide
- Helena College: +8.2% institutional; +6.6% system-wide
- Highlands College: +7.1% institutional; +5.7% system-wide

The comparison of institutional and system-wide rates (within an institution) allow for the calculation of 1-year transfer rates and the full picture of cohort retention within the MUS.

- For the Fall 2011 cohort, campuses with the widest spread between institutional and system-wide rates (i.e. the highest transfer rates) are: Dawson CC (10.3%), MT Tech (8.9%), UM Western - bach. cohort (8.4%), MSU Billings (7.7%), and Great Falls College (7.5%)
