ITEM 158-2001-R0313 Authorization to Upgrade the North Hedges Elevator System - Montana State University

THAT

Consistent with the provisions of MCA-18-2-102(2)(b), the Board of Regents of Higher Education authorizes MSU to upgrade the elevator system in the North Hedges residence hall at MSU-Bozeman. This request is for a total of \$275,000.

EXPLANATION

- The programs, services and amenities provided to students by MSU's housing enterprise contribute to student success and retention; The North Hedges Residence Hall elevator system at the Bozeman campus has not been updated in several decades and needs to be modernized to improve performance and reduce energy consumption.
- 2. The North Hedges elevator system is heavily utilized on a daily basis and has reached its useful life expectancy. It is in need of modernization to extend its operational usefulness and reliability.
- 3. MSU plans to upgrade and modernize the North Hedges elevator system for a total project value of \$275,000.
- 4. This project will be funded by maintenance funds from Auxiliary Operations Revenue (Renewal and Replacement Budget) in excess of debt service obligations.
- 5. All operations & maintenance costs will be paid from Auxiliary Operations Revenue.
