
Fiscal Year Enrollment Report – FY13

- ❖ Enrollment in the MUS declined by 667 student FTE from FY 2012 to FY 2013
- ❖ Total FTE remains over 40,000 FTE despite the -1.7% drop in FY 2013
- ❖ Enrollment has grown by approximately 5,200 FTE (15%) in the past ten years, with over 90% of the growth occurring between 2008 and 2011

1-Year Comparison

- ❖ -1.7% decline from last fiscal year, equaling a drop of 677 FTE
- Resident Undergraduates witnessed the largest decline (-876)
- Non-resident Undergraduates and WUE experienced the largest increases (144; 140)

10-Year Comparison

- ❖ 15% growth over last ten years, equaling an increase of 5,194 FTE
- Resident students represent a slight majority of the growth (+2,629 FTE), 51% of the total increase



10-Year Comparison

- ❖ 2-year Colleges (formally COTs) experienced the largest percent increase over the past ten years (+72%)
- ❖ 4-year campuses recorded the largest numerical increase (+2,533 FTE), followed closely by the 2-year Colleges (+2,497)

Ten Year FTE Growth by Sector




Student FTE by Campus Type

Resident FTE by Campus Type

- ❖ 1-year: resident student FTE declined by more than 1,000 FTE
- ❖ 10-year: 2-year Colleges witnessed largest growth, both numerical and percentage
- ❖ 85% of the growth in resident student enrollment in the past ten years occurred at the 2-year Colleges (formally called COTs)

Non-resident FTE by Campus

- **1-year:** non-resident enrollment grew by 3.9%, growing primarily at 4-year campuses
- ❖ 10-year: 39% increase in non-resident FTE; 85% of growth occurring at 4-year campuses

MT High School Graduates

- Due to the declining high school age population, the number of public high school graduates was 700 students fewer than it was 2004-05 (for the past two years)
- While the MUS capture rate has remained steady, the number attending immediately following graduation has started to decline
- Fall 2011 headcount report: 1st-time resident enrollment down 499 students Fall 2012 headcount report: 1st-time resident enrollment down 360 students
