- "...makes it possible for you to work at your pace, studying only the things that you need to learn."

- "...assessment is consistent with the institution's or program's accreditation."

# **Competency Based Education (Learning)**

### Traditional Programs/Courses

- Fall, Spring, Summer
- 5, 8, 10, 16 week long classes (Weekend College)
- Instructional hours: 15 to 90/credit
- Lecture, Lab, Clinical, Flipped, Blocked, Web Based, Blended
- All students progress at the same pace (Grading Scale)

### Competency Programs/Courses

- Progress after Self-Mastery (Pass Assessment)
- Move to next subject after passing with favorable assessment
