RE: Campus Report for January 2015 Board of Regents' Meeting

- President Simon participated in a workforce development roundtable hosted by U.S. Senator Walsh
- President Simon participated in the Montana Career and Technical Education Advisory Board meeting in Helena
- The college has developed a survey instrument to collect input from students, faculty, and staff on the degree to which the campus facilities and services support teaching and learning. The college will distribute the instrument in December.
- The board of faculty and trustees have adopted a balanced scorecard (Kaplan & Norton, 1996) to facilitate monitoring key performance indicators of mission fulfillment.
- The DCC Music Department and student Music Club performed the annual Madrigal Dinner on December 6 to a sold out audience.
- The college has transitioned to chartering transportation services in order to increase safety and save money.
- The college is working with the Montana State University Community Design Center to have students from the College of Arts and Architecture create a facilities master plan for the campus.
