<u>Request for</u> <u>Authorization to Construct Museum of the Rockies Collection/Storage Facility; Montana State</u> <u>University</u>

THAT

Consistent with the provisions of MCA-18-2-102(2)(c), the Board of Regents of Higher Education authorizes Montana State University to construct a collection/storage facility for the Museum of the Rockies at MSU. This ITEM increases the existing authority to a total of \$3,950,000.

EXPLANATION

- Board of Regents ITEM 164-2008-R0914 authorized MSU to spend up to \$3,500,000 for the construction of the collections/storage facility for the Museum of the Rockies at MSU Bozeman. This request increases the amount authorized by the Regents to a total amount of \$3,950,000.
- 2. The original authorization request was based on a preliminary program outlining a 12,000sf facility. The completion of a more refined program and schematic design identified a 19,000sf facility which would better accommodate the Museum of the Rockies storage needs and related operations.
- 3. Inadequate space for collections storage has been an identified need for the Museum of the Rockies for many years and was noted as a concern in the 2008 accreditation by the American Alliance of Museums. The MOR's inability to properly house the University's collections threatens the mission as a collecting museum and the MOR's recognition as a repository for paleontological specimens found on federal land.
- 4. The project will look to expand the existing capacity of the MOR's collections and museum storage through the construction of a new facility /addition to the existing MOR building. The project encompasses construction of a secure, climate-controlled two-story collection and storage facility along with support spaces at the southwest corner of the existing building.
- 5. The movement of stored collections will be improved by the addition of a new loading dock and freight elevator as part of the storage facility.
- 6. The Board of Trusties of Museum of the Rockies, Inc. has currently funded \$3.85 million of the construction costs. Additional donations and/or non-state funding for the project are expected.
- 7. No state funds will be used for construction or operations and maintenance of this new non-state funded facility.
- 8. This project requires the authorization of the Board of Regents and the Consent of the Governor.
