## **MUS Job Category Taxonomy - DETAIL**

The following job categorization taxonomy identifies the MUS approach to consistently categorizing jobs throughout the System.

This methodology relies on a 6 digit JCAT code adopted and modified from the University of North Carolina.

Campuses are instructed to apply the 6 digit codes in Banner to all employees, using the JCAT framework.

The JCAT codes are then rolled up to create meaningful cateogories for System and Campus analysis.

## Managerial Professionals

Persons whose primary assignments involve professional & administrative activities within a customarily-recognized division/department of the institution, and who are subordinate to individuals in Category 1 (Executive Administrators). All are FLSA Exempt.

These positions are reported with Other Professionals (Category 4) for IPEDS reporting purposes: While they may hold an administrative title, they meet the IPEDS definition of a professional (perhaps are even a "solo expert" with an area of specialized content expertise), with a primary purpose of supporting academic, student service, or other institutional activities at the professional level.
