

Dual Enrollment Pilot Project

- Three-year pilot program offers free dual credit for high school students enrolled at Custer County District High School (CCDHS) and Sidney High School (SHS)
- No credit limits, some students enrolled in as many 14 credits this term
- "The tuition free program only enhances our relationship with MCC and other programs such as the Pioneer Express." Beez Lucero-CCDH Principal

Pioneer Express: Accelerated Degree Completion Program

- Combines dual credit in SHS and CCDHS with MCC Early College options online or on campus
- Allows students to complete a C.A.S. in General Studies while still in high school, or an A.A./A.S. degree with only one year of study after high school
- Depth of dual credit offerings and supportive school district administration made CCDHS and SHS ideal partners
