ASUM Kless Revolving Energy Loan Fund (KRELF) Project Highlights, Spring 2017

87.5% of ASUM Sustainability Fee revenues are directed to the Kless Revolving Energy Loan Fund (KRELF). Since 2010, ASUM's KRELF has funded over 50 projects across the University of Montana campus, some of the highlights include:

- 52 Smart metering systems installed in 38 of 62 buildings at UM, with 2 more in FY 2018
- 18 kW **solar PV** across 5 buildings
- Off-Grid LED street light in front of Rec Center
- In-room **recycling bins** in residence halls
- 8 water-bottling filling stations around campus
- Various energy efficiency projects across campus
 - o ASUM office lighting retrofits & daylight sensors
 - Rec Center daylight harvesting & lighting upgrade
 - Griz Pool lighting update
 - o Piping insulation in Rec center
 - Lommasson Center insulation improvements
 - Laundry exhaust fan control at Aber
 - Variable frequency drives installed on Rec Center air handlers
- Funding of **student trips** to national solar and human-powered vehicle competitions
- Energy Star washer & dryer upgrades installed in Aber & Jesse
 Dorms
- University Center pedal-powered PA system
