The Associated Students of the University of Montana 1 2 Resolution Regarding a Health Fee Increase for the 2018 - 2019 Biennium 3 April 12th, 2017 4 SB80-16/17 5 Authored by: Chase Greenfield, ASUM Business Manager; 6 Sponsored by: Sam Forstag, ASUM President 7 8 Whereas, The Associated Students of the University of Montana (ASUM) is the official 9 representative body of the students of the University of Montana (UM); 10 11 Whereas, earlier this semester, ASUM passed SB59-16/17, a resolution endorsing the continued 12 prioritization and support for mental health resources at UM in the Curry Health Center; 13 14 Whereas, mental health services are critical to the students in the Montana University System; 15 16 Whereas, an analysisi conducted by the Center for Collegiate Mental Health shows that students' 17 self-reported distress levels for depression and anxiety have continued to increase over the past 18 six (6) years; 19 20 Whereas, the total number of scheduled service hours have increased by 28% over the past six 21 (6) years according to the same report; 22 23 Whereas, a September 15 study by the Montana University System (MUS) 'Suicide Prevention and Student Mental Health Task Force² found that: "Campuses have seen a significant increase 24 25 (16% over the last five years) in utilization of mental health services." 26 27 Whereas, this same report from the MUS Suicide Prevention and Mental Health Task Force 28 found that "Campuses do not have adequate staffing or resources to address the need for 29 services." 30 31 Whereas, the Curry Health Center (CHC) receives approximately 30,000 clinical visits each year 32 across its Medical, Counseling, and Dental services; 33 34 Whereas, the CHC also provides approximately 35,000 non-clinical outreach encounters to 35 students each year; 36 37 Whereas, the CHC is anticipating a \$330,000 budget shortfall for the 2018-2019 biennium due to 38 anticipated increases in personnel wages and the currently-projected 5% enrollment decline 39 would require a fee increase of approximately 3.9% to stave off cuts entirely; 40 41 Whereas, some level of fee increase is important to University of Montana students and critical 42 retention and mental health resources, and is uniquely necessary to ensure that students' access 43 to critical components of CHC core services is not impaired over the 2018 - 2019 biennium; 44 45 Therefore, Let it Be Resolved, that the Associated Students of the University of Montana 46 (ASUM) requests that the Board of Regents consider and approve a 3% fee increase to the
