STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT

- Students in the MT Tech Civil Engineering Print Reading class (ECIV 291) reviewed the prints and specifications for the Southwest Montana Veteran's Home, and laid out several of the rooms in the HPER building to check for accessibility and other issues. This was done in cooperation with the MT Tech Athletic Department and MT Tech Nursing Department. Tom Goyette and Eileen Greb, both Vietnam Veterans and members of the SW Mountain Veteran's Home Foundation, were on hand to document accessibility and feasibility of the plans. - Former Montana Tech Metallurgy Major Nick Mowrer took 4th place at the USA Shooting (US Olympic Team) National Championship 3-Position rifle

- Nick Mowrer competes in both rifle and pistol events. He is a triple-distinguished shooter. - Nick Mowrer was the National Collegiate Pistol Champion for Montana Tech in 2008, barely edging Billings, MT native Seth Berglee, who was competing for Ohio State. Ohio State then recruited Nick away from Montana Tech with a scholarship. Nick Mowrer is currently a member of the US Army World Class Athlete Program. Seth Berglee later joined the Army Marksmanship Unit and is currently the Representative for Montana House District 58, Majority Whip, and Chairman of the House Education Committee. Both Mowrer and Berglee have won multiple titles and events in the shooting sports.

• Between July 13 and 20, 2019 a delegation from the University of Kashmir (India) will visit the Montana Tech Campus. The purpose of their visit is to discuss the results of a collaborative project that was initiated between Montana Tech associate professor Dr. Robert Pal and University of Kashmir associate professor Dr. Manzoor A. Shah. It is a prestigious U.S.-India 21st Century Knowledge Initiative Award, for the project titled "Proactive management models for the effects of climate change on the range of invasive species." 2019 is the final year of the three-year grant, which already resulted in valuable scientific outcomes and a vivid relationship with mutual visits of faculty and students between the two universities.
