




MUS 4YR campus resident tuition rates remain well below regional averages




MUS 2YR campus resident tuition rates are close to regional averages




MUS 4YR campus <u>non</u>-resident tuition rates are close to regional averages

Over the past 10 years, tuition increases in the western region have grown over twice as much as the MUS




## Regional Tuition & Fees Comparison
