Montana Educational Talent Search Who We Are :

- Direct service TRIO program funded by the U.S. Department of Education
- Funded to serve 1287 students
- Work with 9 school districts and 16 schools
- Team of 10 state staff
 - 7 Pre-College Advisors working in local communities
 - 3 Helena staff
- PCAs work with 150-190 students each year
- Primarily work with 6th-12th grade students
- Up to 10% of our students served are stop-out, non-traditional

Senior Cohorts

- Average between 200-230 students each year

Montana GEAR UP

- Gaining Early Awareness and Readiness for Undergraduate Programs (GEAR UP)
- Current state staff includes: program director, program manager, school grant manager, and federal grant accountant.
 - Liaisons in all 19 GEAR UP schools
- Entering the 3rd year of a 7-year \$24.5 million grant awarded by US Department of Education
- Celebrating 20 years of serving Montana students
- Increase the number of low-income students prepared to succeed in postsecondary education





Montana GEAR UP State Services

- Serve 7th 12th grade students in 19 schools to:
 - Increase graduation rates
 - Improve academic performance
 - Increase knowledge of postsecondary educational options
- Partner with state's postsecondary institutions to:
 - Support GEAR UP college freshmen
 - Promote college access
 - Support college visits
- Fund the ACT Test

FAFSA Events 2018


52% of graduating seniors completed the FAFSA application
