


Concurrent Enrollment by the Numbers


- More than half (**54%**) of Montana public schools had students participating in concurrent enrollment in 2018-19.
- **76%** increase in the number of Montana public high schools with students participating in concurrent enrollment over the past five years (2014-15 to 2018-19).
- **94%** of large/urban (Class AA & A) and **43%** of small/rural (Class B & C) Montana public high schools had students participating in concurrent enrollment in 2018-19.
- **159%** increase in the number of small/rural (Class B & C) Montana public high schools with students participating in concurrent enrollment over the past five years (2014-15 to 2018-19).



Percent of Montana public high schools with one or more students participating in concurrent enrollment, 2014-15 to 2018-19




Percent of Montana public high schools with one or more students participating in concurrent enrollment, Class AA & A vs. Class B & C, 2014-15 to 2018-19





Percent increase of Montana public high schools with one or more students participating in concurrent enrollment from 2014-15 to 2018-19, by MHSA class size






Class B & C Montana Public High Schools with Students Participating in Concurrent Enrollment 2014-2015









Class B & C Montana Public High Schools with Students Participating in Concurrent Enrollment 2018-2019











2014-15 Concurrent Enrollment, CTE vs. GenEd
