- Montana Tech conferred 506 certificates, associate degrees, bachelor's degrees, master's degrees, and PhDs for spring 2020 commencement.
- Montana Tech announced the class of 2020 valedictorians and other student awards
- <u>Ashton Cummings</u> received the Gold Medal Award from the Montana Society
 of Engineers ("MSE"). MSE provides the award to an outstanding senior
 graduating in engineering from Montana Tech.
- 20 Butte students pursuing their education at Montana Tech in the fall of 2020 were awarded scholarships. 3 were awarded the Montana Opportunity Scholarships. This scholarship provides all the costs associated with attending Montana Tech: tuition, fees, room and board, and books. 17 students were awarded the Liberty Oil Scholarship. Liberty Oilfield Services made a 10-year, \$40,000/year commitment to Montana Tech to provide opportunities for students with financial need to make their educational dreams a reality.
- Montana Tech names <u>Student Employee of the Year</u>. 13 students were nominated for their outstanding contributions and achievements to the university. The selection committee chose Dakota Brown, a Help Desk Associate for Information Technology. The Montana Tech 2020 Student Employee of the Year award nominations were critiqued based upon each nominee's characteristics in the areas of Reliability, Quality of Work, Initiative, Professionalism, and Uniqueness of Contribution to the employer.
- Digger Athletics Association Auction was moved to an online format this year.
 The Digger Auction raised \$114,000. The annual fundraiser supporting Montana Tech's student-athletes and athletic programs was a week-long online fundraising and giving event. The auction is the primary fundraiser for Digger Athletics and Montana Tech student-athletes.
