SUBJECT: FINANCIAL AFFAIRS Policy 940.2 – Application Fee Approved: November 18, 1999. Revised: September 19, 2013; <u>Revised: September 17, 2020</u>

I. Board Policy

A. Each campus of the Montana University System shall <u>may</u> charge a non-refundable application fee of \$30.00 to each applicant for admission to a graduate or undergraduate program. Campuses may exempt applicants for special or non-degree programs authorized by Section 301.

B. If an applicant for a special or non-degree student program authorized by Section 301 later applies for enrollment in the campus's regular program, the application fee shall <u>may</u> be charged at that time.

C. This policy does not apply to special campaigns to increase college access through fee waiver or deferral approved by the Commissioner of Higher Education.

II. Interpretation

A. The application fee shall be honored for one year from the semester for which the student is applying.
