# ITEM 194-104-R0521 Request for Approval of the 2023 Biennial Budget Recommendations

# THAT

The Board of Regents adopts the 2023 Biennial Budget Recommendations for setting tuition and fees, allocating state appropriations, and distributing performance funding.

# **EXPLANATION**

The 2023 Biennial Budget Recommendations are summarized in the following categories:

# Tuition

- Freeze resident undergraduate tuition in FY 2022
- Increase resident undergraduate tuition 3% in FY 2023
- Increase resident graduate and non-resident tuition rates up to 5% annually on each campus

#### Fees

- Hold annual increases to mandatory fees at or below 3% on each campus
- Approve increases to program and course fees, as well as other designated fees including room and board

#### **State Appropriations**

- Allocate \$8.5M of state appropriations to the MUS Ed. Units to address present law adjustments, including \$2M for the pay plan, for a total of \$10.5M
- Key points: 1) systemwide reductions based on 3-year average resident enrollment; 2) provide an adjustment to specific campuses to address inequities related to state funding per resident student; and 3) distribute pay plan funding based a 55 cent per hour increase

#### **Performance Funding**

Allocate \$13.5M out of the designated \$15M based on performance funding metrics
