



# National Trends – Fall 2021 Enrollment


Fall 2021 enrollment numbers show no signs of recovery from last year's declines.

- Undergraduate enrollment is *down 3.2 percent* from a year ago.
- Undergraduate student numbers have now *fallen by 6.5 percent* as a total from two years ago.
- Graduate enrollment continued to grow, reaching 2.1 percent above last fall's level, for a total growth of 5.3 percent over two years.
- First-year student numbers *declined by 3.1 percent* overall and 3.9 percent among traditional-age students (18-20).
