Request for Authorization to Plan and Design the Relocation of the Facilities Maintenance Yard and Ancillary Facilities; Montana State University

THAT

Consistent with BOR Policy 1003.7 authorization for building projects the Board of Regents authorizes Montana State University to expend up to \$2.0 million to program, plan and design for relocating the facilities maintenance yard, ancillary buildings and associated infrastructure.

EXPLANATION

- 1. Montana State University (MSU) received legislative authority-only approval during the 66th Legislative session under HB 5 in the amount of \$9,000,000 for the facilities yard relocation.
- 2. MSU will utilize up to \$2,000,000 of this authority for the programming, planning and design work.
- 3. The facilities yard and associated buildings currently occupy 81,805 square feet of building space on approximately 8.5 acres in the southeast portion of campus along 7th Avenue and Grant Street.
- 4. The project will relocate existing functions and consolidate operations into a more efficient layout to service campus. The Plew Building and Heating Plant will remain in their current locations.
- 5. By relocating several obsolete structures on 7th Avenue, MSU is planning for future academic and institutional buildings along 7th Avenue that better align with campus growth.
- 6. This work will be paid using physical plant funds.
- 7. MSU will request construction authority once planning and design work is completed.
