Request for Authorization to Program, Plan and Design a Building to House the Gianforte School of Computing and Computing-Related Fields; Montana State University

THAT

Consistent with the Board's authority to manage and control the Montana University System, BOR Policy 1003.7, and MCA 20-25-302 (6)(a), the Board of Regents authorizes Montana State University to expend up to \$5,000,000 for planning, programming, design and associated pre-construction activities for a new facility at MSU.

EXPLANATION

- Montana State University (MSU) received a \$50 million donation from the Gianforte Family
 Foundation to construct a new building on the Bozeman campus to house the Gianforte School of
 Computing and computing-related fields such as cybersecurity, optics and photonics, electrical and
 computer engineering and creative industries.
- 2. The computing program currently has faculty and staff distributed across five buildings. A consolidated facility will improve collaboration among colleagues and improve student access to faculty and support services.
- 3. The Bureau of Labor Statistics projects 22% employment growth in computer and information research science between 2022 and 2030. A new purpose-built facility will help MSU and the State of Montana respond to this market demand.
- 4. The facility will be designed to support interdisciplinary collaboration and access across broad academic branches of the University.
- 5. This request is for planning, design and pre-construction only to define the project scope and develop plans for a new facility.
- 6. MSU will request additional construction authority once initial planning and design phases are complete.
- 7. This work will be paid for using private donations.
