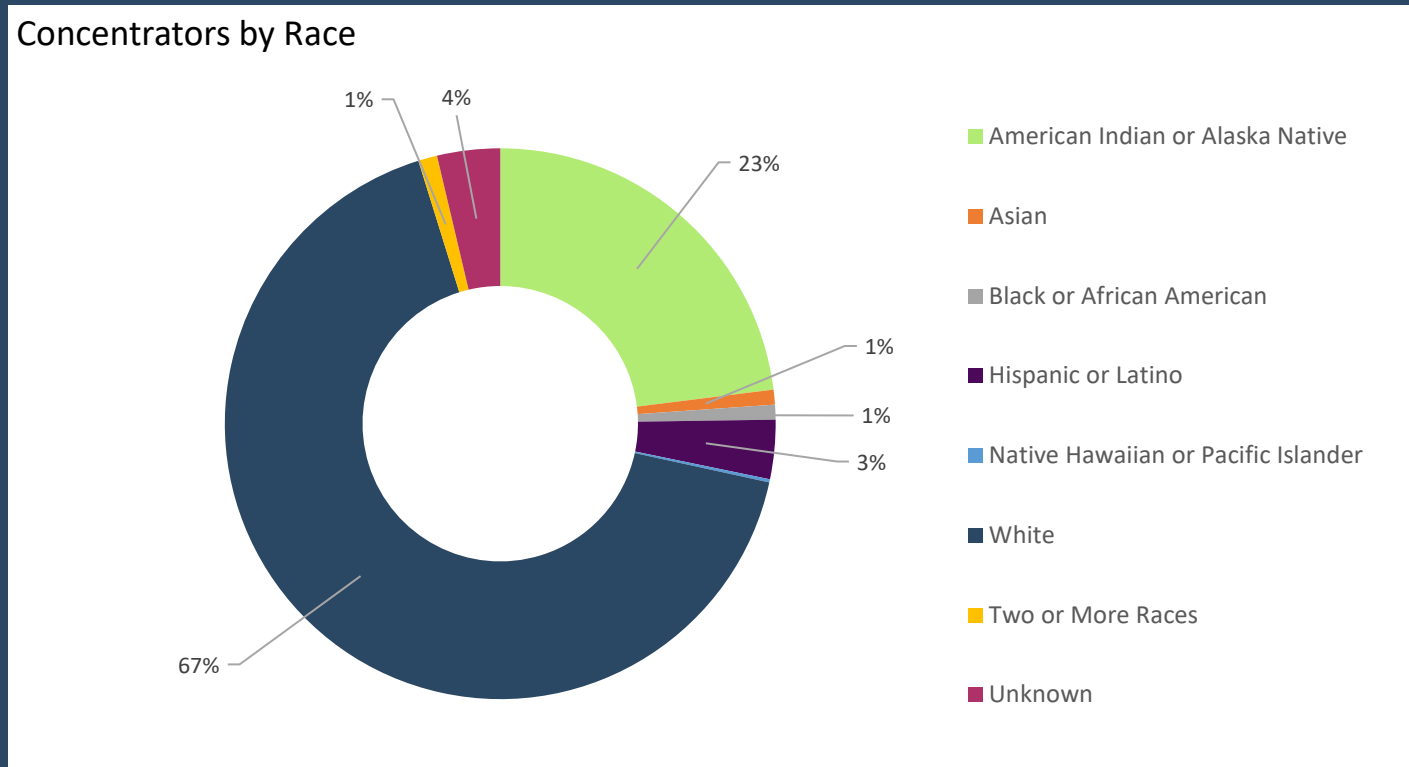

**Percent of Participants in 1+ Special Populations Categories**

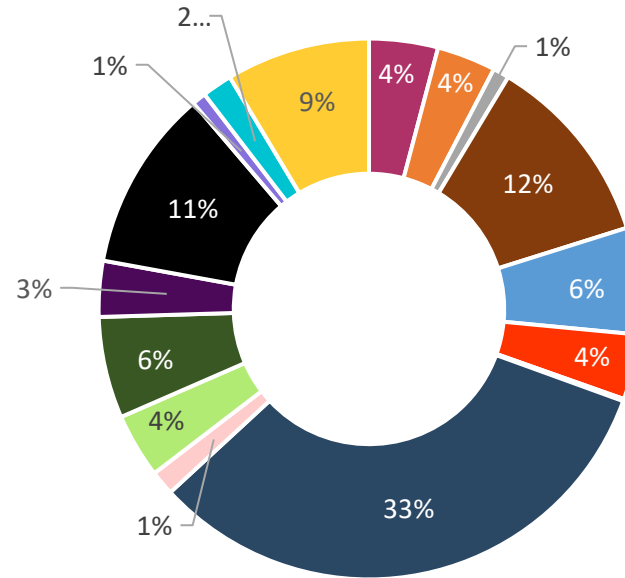
