Request for Authorization to Program and Design an Indoor Practice Facility; Montana State University

THAT

Consistent with the Board's authority to manage and control the Montana University System, the provisions of BOR Policy 1003.7, and MCA 20-25-302(6), the Board of Regents authorizes Montana State University to expend up to \$1,500,000 toward programming and design services for an indoor practice facility.

EXPLANATION

- 1. MSU seeks approval to engage an architect for the purpose of providing programming and design services for a new indoor practice facility on the Bozeman campus.
- 2. Creation of an indoor practice facility is consistent with the needs identified in the Athletic Facilities Master Plan developed in 2017.
- 3. Harsh Montana weather, impacts from regional wildfire smoke, and limitations of existing facilities create year-round challenges for providing safe access to training for student-athletes, thereby limiting practice seasons and creating schedule challenges that negatively impact academic and athletic performance for student-athletes.
- 4. The indoor practice facility project will provide access to year-round training for all student-athletes, improve safety, and streamline the continuity of operations for all MSU athletic programs.
- 5. The indoor practice facility site is anticipated to be proximal to Bobcat Stadium. A methodical site planning exercise as part of the programming and design process will finalize the site.
- 6. The proposed planning and design work will be financed with non-state funds (donations).
- 7. This request authorizes programming and design only. This item does not authorize construction, financing, or operations & maintenance funding for this project.
