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
RIDE MISSION:

Develop Montana <u>dentists</u> who will make a personal commitment to <u>serving</u> the needs of <u>rural</u> and underserved






WHAT PROBLEMS COULD POOR DENTAL HEALTH CAUSE?

DENTISTS BY COUNTY IN MONTANA (2015)




80% of Montana dentists practice in 9 counties.

RURAL DENTIST SHORTAGE:


- Without targeted programs, less than 1 of every 20 graduating dentists choose to practice in rural areas.
- Just as WWAMI addresses the shortage of primary care doctors, RIDE has a similar intention for dentists.

WHY MONTANA RIDE:

- Higher education STEM opportunities for Montanans
 - 32 student slots
- Investment in expanded dental workforce in rural and underserved areas in Montana (WWAMI model).
 - 79% of WA RIDE grads are in rural/underserved
- Increased MT clinical capacity through student rotations in community health centers, tribal health and IHS sites
 - During the RIDE pilot (2016-2021), 68 Montana rotations provided 12,240 hrs of service to MT dental clinics.



MONTANA RIDE CURRICULUM

YEAR 1: MONTANA STATE UNIVERSITY

MT RIDE dental students in existing MSU WWAMI infrastructure.



YEAR 3: UNIV OF WA- SEATTLE

Clerkship and comprehensive care clinical training in Seattle.



YEAR 2: RUOP ROTATION – MONTANA

Four-week clinical rotation in rural Montana communities.



YEAR 4: EXTENDED ROTATION – MONTANA


Five-month clinical rotation in rural Montana communities.

Partners MSU and UM provide interprofessional education (IPE)




Didactic and pre-clinic courses in Spokane.





MONTANA RIDE PARTNERS



RIDE EDUCATIONAL OUTCOMES

- 78% of practicing dental RIDE graduates are in rural/underserved areas in the state and region.
 N = 72 (2012-2020, 9 cohorts)
- RIDE dentists prefer community health and rural working environments
- Educational equivalence of RIDE track affirmed in accreditation site visits in 2012 & 2016
- High student and preceptor satisfaction, the RIDE program has more applicants than we can accept


