\$1 Million Grant Funded by the Dennis and Phyllis Washington Foundation designed with three goals in mind:





- Train high school students in a CTE field in the community where they live;
- Grow an understanding of the need for more training in the field among students, educators, community members and family members;
- Promote/Market the CTE field to local and state stakeholders
