# Request for Authority to Increase Spending to Remodel Research Storage Building at Flathead Lake Biological Station – University of Montana-Missoula

#### **THAT**

Consistent with the Board's authority to manage and control the Montana University System, BOR Policy 1003.7 and 20-25-108(1)(f), MCA, the Board of Regents of the Montana University System authorizes the University of Montana – Missoula to expend up to \$660,000 for the Remodel of Research Support Building at Flathead Lake Biological Station (FLBS).

## **EXPLANATION**

- 1. The Board of Regents authorized UM to expend \$500,000 for this project in September 2020 (Item 190-1011-R0920). This item increases the authorized spending authority to \$660,000.
- 2. The Research Support Building at Flathead Lake Biological Station (FLBS) has approximately 1,150 SF of unfinished space on the first floor.
- 3. An NSF federal research grant was obtained to in 2020 to finish the building project by adding labs, a walk-in freezer, and an ADA restroom to the existing space.
- 4. Bids for the proposed project came in higher than original funding and estimates. The FLBS was able to secure the additional federal grant funding to continue the project.
- 5. This project is fully funded from an NSF federal research grant.
