Upon the occasion of the retirement of Dr. Kevin O'Neill from the College of Agriculture at Montana State University, the Board of Regents wishes to express its appreciation for their service to the University, the Montana University System, and the people of the State of Montana.

EXPLANATION

Dr. Kevin M. O'Neill, whose distinguished career as a professor of entomology at Montana State University has demonstrated his unwavering commitment to research, teaching, and mentorship, has demonstrated exemplary contributions to his discipline and university for 39 years. Dr. O'Neill has made significant contributions to the field of insect ecology, particularly focusing on pollinator behavior, solitary wasps, and bees.
