[Advanced Stroke Life Support Training Grant](#) – MSU Northern’s College of Health Sciences was awarded a \$17,800 grant from Accelerate Montana to provide free Advanced Stroke Life Support (ASLS®) training to 40-50 healthcare professionals across Montana, with a focus on rural communities along the Hi-Line. The training will also benefit MSU-Northern students and faculty, who can receive the certification at no cost.

[Athletes in Service Award](#) - Emily Feller received the Montana Athletes in Service Award for MSU Northern during the half-time of the Brawl of the Wild football game. Emily Feller has been deeply involved in community service throughout her time as a student-athlete at MSU Northern. She has contributed to several local initiatives, including participating in the Adopt-a-Highway cleanup program and organizing the Halloween Trunk or Treat event for youth in Havre through her involvement in the Association of Student Athletes.

[Cowboy Christmas](#) - the MSU Northern Rodeo Booster Club hosted the 25th Annual Cowboy Christmas Fundraiser in the Armory Gym. The event raised over \$100K and celebrated the accomplishments of the MSU Northern rodeo team. The Outstanding Advocate of the Year Award went to Matt Wertheimer.

[NCLEX-RN Pass Rates](#) – MSU Northern's nursing program continues to excel, with graduates achieving an impressive 80% first-time NCLEX-RN pass rate in 2024 and a 100% ultimate pass rate. These results reflect the program's commitment to preparing students for success in their nursing careers.

[Dean's List](#) – The Montana State University Northern’s Fall semester Dean’s List contains 325 students. To be included in the Dean’s List, students must carry a minimum of 12 credits and earn a grade point average of 3.25 or better.

[Bingo Night](#) - Delivered Big Prizes ASMSUN Activities and Events sponsored the 2nd Annual Student BINGO night on Wednesday December 4th in the SUB Ballroom. There were over 180 students in attendance who battled in the game of chance – 13 rounds with almost \$5000 in prizes.
