- Online enrollments for Summer 690.
- All staff positions filled for first full year in the new Academic Support Center focusing on retention and student success.
- National Youth Sports Summer Program 2001 Summer Camp held on MSU-Billings campus providing summer camp opportunities for community youth who cannot afford camps offered on a fee basis.
- *We the People... The Citizen and the Constitution* Mountain/Plains Region Summer Institute held on MSU-Billings campus June 19-26, 2001.
- Passport Program proposal awarded to College of Technology. Passport Program is a partnership with the YWCA which will assist eligible families by providing scholarships for training that will lead to higher wage level positions.
- National Association of Schools of Music Commission on Accreditation voted to accept the MSU-Billings Music Department's progress report.
- MSU-Billings College of Technology will host an ACT Center beginning this fall with a computer network system that will enhance our current workforce development programs and services. The main areas of emphasis of the ACT Centers are Adult Literacy/Employability Skills, Computer Basics, Information Technology, English as a Second Language, Management and Leadership, Personal and Professional Development, Industrial Technology, Occupational Training and Safety Skills.
- Search for a Dean of the College of Business has been initiated.
- Search for a Dean of the College of Technology has been initiated.
- Student Opportunity Services Grant renewed for four years.
