SUBJECT: Course and Miscellaneous Fee Changes – FY2003

The Montana University Campuses are proposing the enclosed changes to course fees and miscellaneous fees for FY2003. This is an inclusive list of their proposed changes so that you know exactly what you are being asked to approve in the Inventory of Fees.

Two fee items that are not yet finalized again this year are the room and board rates (auxiliaries) and optional student health insurance. The campuses are projecting room and board increases in the following ranges for FY2003:

Proposal January 25, 2002 **Program Fee Miners Training – Montana Tech**

Montana Tech was the recipient of an earmark project to provide underground miner training through the Department of Labor. The program is 15 weeks of training running from 8 am to 5pm, 5 days a week. This is the equivalent of 800 contact hours. The program is an intensive training on a variety of pieces of equipment which requires increased delivery costs. The contact hours are equivalent to obtaining 54 credits in a 15 weeks period or the equivalent of 4.5 semesters. The program cost per student is \$12,500.

Because this is an alternative delivery format, Montana Tech is requesting the ability to charge an equivalent of 4.5 semesters of tuition and a program fee to each student. Four and onehalf semesters of COT tuition equates to \$4,077. An additional \$7,258 program fee is required to adequately deliver the training.

Montana Tech is requesting a super tuition of \$4,077 and a program fee of \$7,258.

Proposal February 22, 2002 *Program Fee Healthcare Informatics Montana Tech*

A program fee is requested to support the highly specialized vendor software labs associated with the Healthcare Informatics program. The program has a heavy reliance on the use of software and products similar in nature to the SCT Banner software the campuses use. This specialized software requires a dedicated computer coordination position. The cost of that position is \$40,000 with benefits. This is only for the use of the Healthcare Informatics degree.

The program also requires a practicum and internship that require extensive travel.

To cover these costs a \$65 per semester program fee is requested.

Proposal February 22, 2002 **Program Fee Professional and Technical Communication Montana Tech**

A program fee is requested to support continuing development of Montana Tech's Professional and Technical Communications program. This program maintains 3 specialized studios with unique equipment, hardware and software needs (\$33,000/annum). In addition the department requires a Studio Productions Director to oversee and manage the facilities (\$35,000/annum). The program currently depends on a combination of course fees, operations budget allocations, capital equipment requests, and computer and technology fees to maintain these facilities. However, a \$16,000 annual shortfall exists. The department requests a program fee of \$30 per semester be assessed for students in the PTC
