Specify Request:

The University of Montana-Missoula College of Technology seeks approval from the Montana Regents of Higher Education to convert the currently approved Associate of Applied Science program in Practical Nursing to a Certificate Program in Practical Nursing and an Associate of Science Degree leading to licensure as a Registered Nurse. This request for an articulated program comes in response to the increased demand for professional nurses and the University's mission to provide education and training in areas that benefit the local, regional, state and national community. The proposal reflects the ongoing commitment that the UM-MCOT has to its students, the nursing profession and its health care industry partners.
