Rename the School of Pharmacy and Allied Health Sciences and rename three subunits within the unit.

The present designation, School of Pharmacy and Allied Health Sciences, does not adequately describe the activities that currently take place in that unit. Therefore, this request is to rename the School as the College of Health Professions and Biomedical Sciences, and includes changing the name of three subunits under the College, those being:

- Skaggs School of Pharmacy (to be comprised of the Departments of Biomedical and Pharmaceutical Sciences and the Department of Pharmacy Practice)
- School of Social Work (formerly Department of Social Work)
- School of Physical Therapy and Rehabilitation Science (formerly Department of Physical Therapy)
