Long Range Building Plan Request

The project will provide the MSU Billings Art Department with a 12,500 square foot facility dedicated to art teaching spaces, studios, offices, and gallery space for students. The new building will replace the defunct Art Annex Building.

Existing Condition

- The existing Art Annex Building has significant life-safety issues and building system failures and is planned to be demolished once replaced.
- The campus has no appropriate alternative spaces for the Art Department.
