

Exceptions to the Minimum Grade Policy

The University of Montana – Missoula

Anthropology

- must earn a grade of C or better in core courses: ANTH 210N, ANTH 220S, ANTH 250S, ANTH 270
- must earn a grade of C or better in the required quantitative methods course

Art

- must earn a C or better in all Art courses used to satisfy the degree requirements

Business Administration

- must earn a C or better in the following courses:
 - ENEX 101
 - MATH 117 and 241
 - ECON 111S and 112S
 - COMM 111A
 - CS 172
 - ACCT 201 and 202
 - BADM 257
 - IS 270

Communication Studies

- must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 for admission to the program

Davidson Honors College

- must maintain a 3.0 GPA overall
- must maintain a 3.4 GPA in the major
- must have a 3.8 GPA for admission to the Presidential Leadership program

Education

- must have a minimum overall GPA of 2.75 for admission to the program
- must maintain a minimum overall GPA of 2.75
- must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.75 in the field of licensure

English

- must complete nine English credits (excluding ENEX courses) with a grade of C or better **and** a minimum GPA of 2.5 in those courses for admission to the program
- must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 in the previous two terms or 24 credits for admission to the program

Fine Arts, Design Technology option

- must maintain a minimum overall GPA of 2.5, and a 3.0 GPA in design/technology courses

General Education

- must earn a grade of C or better in ENEX 101 (English Composition)
- must earn a grade of C or better in MATH 107, 109, 117, 121, 130 (Mathematical Literacy)

Health and Human Performance

- must earn a grade of C or better in all required courses, including pre-requisites, for the Athletic Training option
- must earn a grade of C or better in the following courses for the Health Enhancement option: teaching major and minor, professional education courses, a drug abuse course, PSYC 100S, ENEX 101, and C&I 427 or ENT 440

Journalism

- must earn and maintain a minimum overall GPA of 2.5 for entry into the professional program

Medical Assisting

- must earn a grade of B or better in all program specific courses, and a grade of C or better in SCN 201N-202N

Modern and Classical Languages and Literatures

- must earn a minimum GPA of 2.5 in all upper-division courses in the language of the major

Music

- must earn a grade of C or better in all required lower-division music courses

Nursing (Practical and Registered)

- must have a minimum GPA of 2.75 for admission to the program
- must earn a grade of B or better in all program specific courses, and in SCN 201N-202N

Pharmacy

- must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 overall and in all pre-professional courses for admission to the program
- must have a grade of C or better for professional courses transferred from another accredited school of pharmacy

Pharmacy Technology

- must earn a grade of B or better in all program specific courses, and a C or better in SCN 201N-202N

Psychology

- must earn a grade of C or better in all psychology courses used to satisfy the degree requirements
- must earn a grade of C or better in the required mathematics course (MATH 117, 150, or 152)

Radiologic Technology

- must have a minimum GPA of 2.75 for admission to the program
- must earn a grade of B or better in all program specific courses, and in SCN 201N-202N

Respiratory Care

- must earn a grade of B or better in all program specific courses, and in SCN 201N-202N

Social Work

- must have a minimum overall GPA of 2.5 to enroll in upper-division courses

Surgical Technology

- must earn a grade of B or better in all program specific courses, and in SCN 201N-202N

Wildlife Biology

- must maintain a minimum overall GPA of 2.5
- must have a minimum GPA of 3.5 for honors emphasis
